

## Zeist-on-Sea

A short multi-cache of two kilometers (1.5 miles).

Global warming is happening now and the sea levels around the world are rising. It might be possible that Zeist will become a seaside resort. In that case, it is good to be prepared. What will you take with you, sunscreen, slippers and a towel? Or stay with the GPSr, walking shoes and a pen?

### The cache

The trail has a length of about two kilometers, one to get to the stash and one to get back. Unfortunately the owner of the area did not grant permission to hide the stash. But thanks to the community of Zeist, it is allowed to hide the stash on their property. The trail can be done between sunrise and sunset.

#### WP1: N 52° 04.849 E005° 15.050

At this place the rules of this small piece of ground are explained in Dutch. Find the picture of an animal, and take the last word. Count the characters of that word. That is answer A.

#### WP2: via N 52° 04.975 E005° 15.070 to N 52° 04.(A-3)33 E005° 14.(A-4)97

The edges of the road are marked with wooden poles and boulders. How many boulders are placed here? They are placed at three locations on both sides of the road. That is answer B.

#### WP3: N 52° 04.(B-1)(B-1)4 E005° 14.(B)11

How many small pillars keep the fences up? That is answer C.

#### WP4: N 52° 04.(B)(A-B)2 E005° 14.(C-1)(B)7

Stay on the sidewalk and beware of the cyclists!

Which character do you find here on the ground? E: D = 59    G: D = 73    K: D = 89    W: D = 101

Make use of the black-and-white route to walk to the next waypoint.

#### WP5: N 52° 04.(9\*D) E005° 14.((8\*D)-2)

Here you find a simple construction of poles, shelves and bolts (the one closest to the road). Subtract the number of poles and shelves from the visible number of bolts. That is answer E.

#### WP6: N 52° 04.(C)(E-1)3 E005° 14.(E)(A-B)4

You have arrived at the theme of this cache. Answer the following questions:

At how many different points is there a contact with the earth? That is answer F.

How many rods carry the construction? That is answer G.

The next question is difficult in English, because the explanation is only in Dutch. You search for one word of five characters, which is mentioned here three times. The description of the word is: "an extravagant structure built to lend interest to a view". Take the value of the last character (A = 1, B = 2, . . .), that is answer H.

#### WP7: N 52° 04.(C)(E-F)(E) E005° 14.(G-C)(F)(B)

You search for two words with an equal number of characters. Take the value of the last character of the first word. That is answer J.

### The stash

You will find the stash at **N 52° 04.(C)(G-A)(J) E005° 14.(G-C)(J)((D-1)/H)**

Digging is not necessary and also not permitted. Use your eyes well, and you will find the stash easily.

After you have logged, please cover the stash wisely. Not too little, not too much! The pieces that are worth to be seen must stay visible. But the weather may have changed the situation before you arrived. When you have found the stash, this cryptic text will explain itself.

After logging you can get back to the parking via **N 52° 04.813 E005° 14.544** and **N 52° 04.820 E005° 14.727**.
